1	Title	Required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Clear, concise, and punchy ▶ Uses appropriate keywords ▶ Action oriented ▶ Maps to the course outcome 		
2	Subtitle	Required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Reinforces title without being redundant 		
3	Topic	Recommended	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Topic is different than others on marketplace ▶ Topic appeals to a specific segment or group of students 		
4	Category	Required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Category is appropriate for topic 		
5	Language	Required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Language selected matches the main language used to teach the course 		
6	Multi-Media	Recommended	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ We recommend planning your course to include multiple lecture types. ▶ These can include video, text, presentation, mashup, or audio lectures. ▶ At least 60% of the course needs to be video 		
7	Novel Approach	Recommended	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Incorporate innovative approaches to covering your course material such as: case studies, structured supplemental materials, etc. 		

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8	Structured Teaching	Recommended	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Create a structured outline for your course ▶ We recommend following this pattern: 'discuss', 'demonstrate', 'do' ▶ Identify key takeaways 		
9	Instructor Engagement	Recommended	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Instructor is available to students and states level of engagement so students know whether instructor is available for webinars, 1:1 coaching, questions, etc. ▶ Engagement in course video lectures is high -- students can sense the instructor's enthusiasm for course topic

10	Audio Quality	Required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Audio is clear, intelligible and audio ▶ Audio has no background noise; hum; hiss; or other distracting noise ▶ No "pops" on Ps or Ts ▶ No echos or other hollow sounds ▶ Audio comes out of both speakers (mono vs. stereo) 		
11	Video Quality	Required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Video has lighting that is bright, balanced, and clear ▶ Background is appropriate and non-distracting ▶ Video is framed appropriately so all subjects are in frame, and clear ▶ Video is loaded directly onto Udemy (not through Youtube or Vimeo) 		
12	HD Quality	Required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Video is shot in full 720p HD (1280x720) 		
13	16:9 Format	Required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Video is filmed and exported in 16:9 widescreen aspect ratio 		
14	Editing Quality	Recommended	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Video is edited and polished ▶ Long pauses and obvious mistakes have been removed ▶ Lectures have smooth transitions at the beginning and the end 		
15	Mobile Optimized	Recommended	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Video objects can be seen clearly even on smaller mobile screens 		
16	Promo Video	Recommended	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Promo video is an accurate reflection of the course content (production values, accent, etc) ▶ Promo video provides examples of course content (what will be covered, how you will cover it, etc)

17	Course Summary	Required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Course Summary contains clear and compelling copy ▶ Include keywords for SEO ▶ Includes formatting (bullet points, lists, etc. to break up paragraphs of text) ▶ [Recommended] includes student recommendations 		
18	Goals and Objectives	Required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Goals are actionable, clear and compelling 		
19	Intended Audience	Required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Audience defines who the course is intended for based on levels of knowledge, experience, or ability ▶ Audience is not "everyone" 		
20	Course Requirements	Required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Requirements include necessary materials to complete the course: software, specific versions of applications, equipment, or attitude. 		
21	Course Outline	Required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Lectures and Sections are grouped into a thoughtful, logical sequence ▶ Lecture and Section titles are appropriate and informative ▶ Outline includes an introduction and a conclusion to the course ▶ Course outline includes at least 5 lectures ▶ Course lectures are under 20 minutes long

22	Instructor Bio	Required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Include sufficient information on the instructor or organization who is teaching the course -- let everyone know who you are! ▶ Image is a non-pixelated photograph (for instructor) or corporate logo (for organization) 		
23	Course Image	Required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Image is 16:9 (widescreen) with dimensions of minimum 480x270 to recommended 960x540. ▶ File type is .jpg, .gif, or .png. ▶ Image is clear, non-pixelated, and appropriate ▶ Course Image does not include: any kind of banner, label such as "free" or "discounted," social media handle, URL, product image (real or otherwise), currency, or action icon like a play button. ▶ NOTE: Udemy can make you an image if you'd like

25	Lecture Descriptions	Recommended	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Lecture descriptions are detailed (they do not just repeat the lecture title) ▶ Recommended length for lecture descriptions is 2-5 sentences 		
26	Supplemental Material	Recommended	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Add useful supplementary material (i.e. presentation slides, readings, Zip file, resources) to a lecture. 		
27	Reinforced Learning	Recommended	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Course has activities, questions, or quizzes to reinforce student learning and engagement with material ▶ Course highlights key takeaways in each lecture and/or section 		
28	Free Lectures	Required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Include at least one free lecture for the course so students can get a sense of your teaching style ▶ At least one free lecture is required 		
29	Course is Complete	Required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Make sure that all of your lectures are published individually (each lecture should turn from yellow to green)
